

## REPORT CARD

### *Program Years 2009-2013*

This unique program is designed to educate, inspire and develop young leaders as the foundation for Iowa's future economic growth and to encourage their on-going involvement in local communities and the state to create a better future for all Iowans. These results are based on the program from start to finish, which totals just eight days plus a mentorship.
